Bid accepted again for Laurelton Center

Once again the former Laurelton Center property will be put out for bids.

State Rep. Russell H. Fairchild, R-85 of Lewisburg announced the news during a recent speech before the League of Women Voters of the Lewisburg area.

According to Fairchild, the property will be put out for bids within 30 days.

The former Laurelton Center property had been under contract to Woodward Camp, but officials from there canceled the contract in June with a termination statement.

They were concerned with leaking underground fuel tanks that might have caused environmental damage.

The sale was eventually called off.

Although Woodward officials said they were still interested in the property, the state decided to begin the process over.

The property located in Hartley Township has 272-acres. Woodward Camp is the most recent of a string of failed deals that also included plans for a hotel and golf course and retirement community.
