## county woman seeks rew TO RECOVER \$500 Charged with obtaining \$500 under false pretenses from Dr. Mary Wolfe, superintendent of the Laurelton State Village, George S. Shimer, Sr., of

false pretenses from Dr. Mary Wolfe, superintendent of the Laurelton State Village, George S. Shimer, Sr., of Milton, former president of the Milton Manufacturing Company, was bound over under bond of \$500 on Monday for a hearing before Justice of the Peace L. F. Lybarger, Jr., of Mifflinburg, on August 7. Shimer is charged with having borrowed \$500 from Dr. Wolfe under false claims that he had borrowed \$500 from Exsenator Charles Steele, of Northumberland, for the same purpose and under the same conditions.

Shimer is alleged to have borrowed the money to buy up options on stock in the Milton Manufacturing Company. Dr. Wolfe charged through her attorney Charles W. Kalp, Esq., that the money which Shimer obtained from Steele was on excellent collateral and that by claiming Steele had loaned him the amount for the purpose of buying up the options on a bonus agreement, Shimer obtained money from her under false pretenses.

The alleged illegality of the loan will be thrashed out at the scheduled hearing before Justice Lybargr.
