What are the requirements and costs for placing a young girl of 13 in the Laurelton State Institution?

Laurelton State Village is a State training school for mentally defective girls and women of child-bearing age. There is a waiting list of more than 600 applicants. The charge for care depends entirely upon the ability of the relatives of the girl to pay for her care. As a State institution Laurelton State Village will give care free of charge to those who cannot pay. On the other hand, if anyone is able to pay all or part of the cost of her maintenance, the State requires that she do so. Actual amount charged is decided upon by the Department of Revenue, which has representatives in each State institution.

An application blank may be filed with Dr. Mary M. Wolfe, superintendent.
